WHEREAS, following disasters, stressed and strained homeowners are vulnerable to predatory practices from dishonest contractors fraudulently inflating repair or rebuilding costs, and

WHEREAS, predatory practices by ultimately increase costs for consumers by driving up insurance premiums and forcing insurers to reevaluate risk; and

WHEREAS, the National Insurance Crime Bureau, in collaboration with its local and state partners in Colorado, including law enforcement, first responders, legislators, and state officials, are committed to educating Coloradans about predatory practices; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Colorado are encouraged to become familiar with contractor fraud and participate in the various programs during annual Contractor Fraud Awareness Week;
